> Designation as an Impaired Insurer under Texas Insurance Code Chapter 2602 10202

General remarks and official action taken:

The commissioner of insurance considered whether Millennium Closing Services, LLC doing business under the assumed name Millennium Title (Millennium Title), which was organized under the laws of the State of Texas and engaged in the business of title insurance in the State of Texas as described in Tex. Ins. Code Ann. § 2501.005, should be designated an impaired title agent as defined in Tex. Ins. Code § 2602.003.

On January 25, 2016, the 53rd District Court of Travis County, Texas entered an Order Appointing Liquidator and Permanent Injunction in Cause No. D-1-GN-16-0360, finding Millennium Closing Services doing business under the assumed name Millennium Title to be insolvent.

Based upon the finding of insolvency by the Court, and having considered the purposes of TEX. INS. CODE Chapter 2602, the Commissioner of Insurance finds that Millennium Closing Services, LLC doing business under the assumed name Millennium Title is designated as an "impaired agent" as that term is defined in TEX. INS. CODE § 2602.003(5), effective January 25, 2016.
